CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with the officials.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Make sure your child's equipment's safe and if good working order.
- Make sure your child has the appropriate safety equipment, for hard ball cricket, box, helmet, gloves and pads. The club does have a few items.
- Never force your child to take part in training/matches.
- Never force your child to play knowing they have injury.
- Let the coaches know if your child has an injury.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances for both teams.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' judgements.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their cricket.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Never coach your child during a game.
- Ensure that any spectators you bring are aware of the club's conducts.
